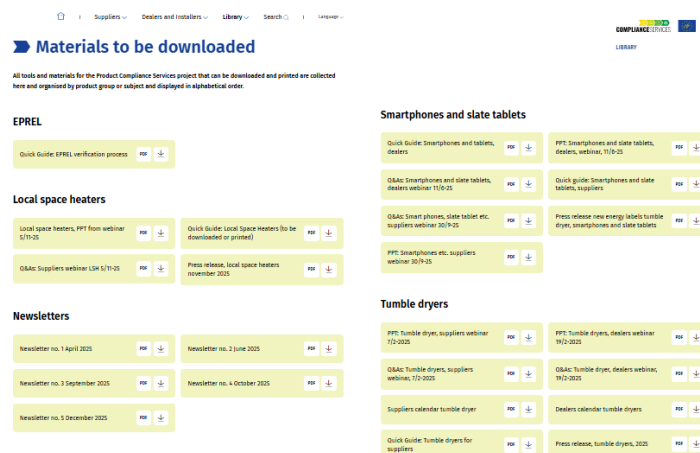

The focus is on new regulations from 2023 to 2027, especially for heating, air conditioning, PV products, smartphones & slate tablets and white goods (washing machines, fridges and freezers). More tools and information will be provided depending on the finalisation of regulations by the European Commission.
