Since 20th of June 2025, smartphones and slate tablets have to be marked with energy labels, and together with other mobile phones and cordless phones they are covered by the ecodesign legislation.

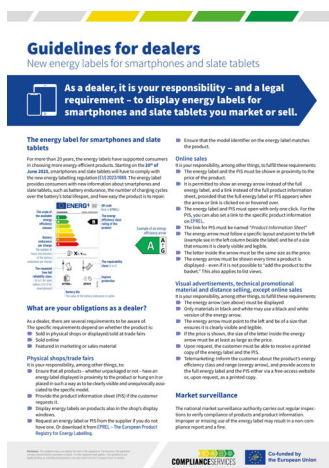
From July 18th, 2025, tumble dryers will be marked with updated energy labels, which provide up-to-date information to customers when choosing a new model at the point of sale.

If you produce, import and/or sell tumble dryers, please be aware of the ecodesign and energy labelling requirements

Energy label and ecodesign

Important regulations to be aware of:

- The ecodesign regulation (EU) 2025/2090 – (EU) 2025/2092
- The energy labelling regulation (EU) 2025/2092 – (EU) 2025/2094

Guide consumers to choose more energy efficient products by providing energy labels, product information sheets, promotional material, information to physical stores and online shops as well as on the EPREL product database. At the same time, they encourage manufacturers to innovate and adopt more efficient technologies.

IMPORTANT!

The EU Commission introduced ecodesign and energy labelling regulations for household tumble dryers in 2025 to support energy and resource efficiency. Both regulations include obligations for suppliers. To update the regulation requirements in line with market and technology developments, the regulations were updated in 2025 with new requirements, which will apply from the 1st of January 2025 until the 31st of July 2025. The regulation of 2025 will be in force until 30th of June 2025.

Which products are covered?

The regulations still in force until end of June 2025 cover built-in household tumble dryers and those sold for non-household use. Afterwards, the new regulations will only cover dryers for household use.

Both the current and the new regulations include:

- Electric multi-ported tumble dryers
- Condenser dryers with heat pump or heat element
- Air-dried dryers
- Gas-fired dryers
- Free-standing and built-in household tumble dryers (all shelf types included)

These tumble dryers are included in the new regulations:

- Multi-door household tumble dryers
- Electric multi-ported household tumble dryers that can also be powered by batteries

Both the current and the new regulations do not apply to:

- Household washer-dryers and household light-tractors (are in the scope of the washing machine regulations).

The new regulations do not apply to:

- Tumble dryers in the scope of Directive 2006/42/EC
- Battery-operated household tumble dryers - even if they can be connected to the main through an AC/DC converter purchased separately.

Ecodesign requirements at a glance

The new regulation includes some additional types of requirements as shown in the table below:

The new ecodesign regulation (EU) 2025/2090	The current ecodesign regulation (EU) 2009/125
Availability of supplier's contact information	not required
Availability of user tips, repair and maintenance information	not required
Requirements on transportation	not required
Minimum energy efficiency and power consumption in id and standby mode	not required
Minimum condenser efficiency for condenser dryers	not required
Minimum heat exchanger	not required
Energy and environmental programme	not required
See manual	not required

Energy labelling requirements at a glance

The EU Commission has adopted a new regulation (EU) 2025/2094 that sets new energy labelling requirements for tumble dryers.

The new regulation has entered into force and will apply from the 1st of July 2025 with some exceptions (please read more in this guideline). Until the 31st of July 2025 the current energy labelling regulation (EU) 2017/1369 will apply. The energy label for tumble dryers will be mandatory, as the energy efficiency classes will change from A to G. Additionally, the Product Eco-label has been updated and moved to the 'Product Information Sheet', with some modifications to its content.

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Suppliers have to deliver new tumble dryer labels to the dealers already since the 1st of March 2025, but retailers should replace them between 1st to 18th of July 2025. Take a look at our **calendars**, where all the deadlines are explained:
