Local space heaters

Are you a supplier of local space heaters?

 We invite you to register and attend a webinar on new ecodesign requirements for local space heaters, that will take place on 5th of November at 14:00 pm CET.

The ecodesign regulation for local space heaters was updated in 2024 with new requirements, which apply for products placed on the market from the 1st of July 2025 onwards, except for provisions on circumvention, which have been applicable since the 9th of May 2024.

 The Compliance Services project webinar on ecodesign requirements for local space heaters is relevant for suppliers and will provide the participants with an overview of the requirements, including clarification of any potential grey areas.

Guidelines for suppliers on local space heaters: Most new ecodesign
provisions on local space heaters apply from the 1st of July 2025. What
exactly are they about and what should the suppliers be aware about?
Our new guidelines provide an overview of the requirements, of changes
compared to the previous legislation and its scope, as well as e.g. a list of
spare parts to be made available, frequently spotted issues in market
surveillance checks, etc.
